HISTORY:

- Klover Products, Inc., was incorporated in March 2012, by Patrick Santini and Paul Terpstra. They formed Klover Products after co-developing their first parabolic microphone product for Fox Sports in 2011, when Fox audio engineers grew dissatisfied with the available products on the market.
- Paul brought experience in engineering and product development while Patrick brought experience in the staging and entertainment industries. **(See bios for further information.)**
- The original test unit for Fox Sports turned out to be the first prototype of the microphone that would later become the Klover MiK™ 26.
- Patrick founded Kernwer LLC, which provides temporary stages and structures to the television broadcast and entertainment industries. He now concentrates his efforts on ModTruss Inc., which grew out of Kernwer and provides modular construction systems for a wide variety of uses.
- Paul operates an engineering consulting company called Innalytical Solutions.
- Innalytical Solutions had been providing Patrick's companies with engineering services for several years before the development of the parabolic microphone, and continues to do so.

ITEMS OF INTEREST:

- Klover MiK™ parabolic microphones have been used to broadcast the Super Bowl, World Series, MLB All-Star game, NBA All-Star game, and the 2015 NCAA men's basketball tournament.
- Fox Sports has used the Klover MiK™ parabolic microphones exclusively for football broadcasts since 2012. They have purchased more than 50 Klover MiK™ systems in that time.
- The U.S. Patent Office has recently approved the patent covering the construction of the larger Klover MiK™ models.
- A second patent application is pending that covers the construction of the Klover MiK-09.
- Klover Products has also developed a system, called the Klear Shot™, for removing water (rain) and debris from the lens of television cameras.
