HISTORY:

- Klover Products, Inc., was incorporated in March 2012, by Patrick Santini and Paul Terpstra. They formed Klover Products after co-developing their first parabolic microphone product for Fox Sports in 2011, when Fox audio engineers grew dissatisfied with the available products on the market.
- The original test unit for Fox Sports turned out to be the first prototype of the microphone that would later become the Klover MiK™ 26.
- Patrick founded Kernwer LLC, which provided temporary stages and structures to the television broadcast and entertainment industries. He later founded ModTruss Inc., which provides modular construction systems for a wide variety of uses. In 2018 Patrick sold his portion of the company to Paul and his wife in order to concentrate on ModTruss.
- Paul operates an engineering consulting company called Innalytical Solutions. Innalytical Solutions had provided Patrick with engineering services for several years before the development of the parabolic microphone.

ITEMS OF INTEREST:

- Klover MiK™ parabolic microphones have been used to broadcast the Super Bowl, World Series, MLB All-Star game, NBA All-Star game, NCAA men's basketball tournament, and Rio Olympics.
- Fox Sports has used the Klover MiK™ parabolic microphones exclusively for football broadcasts since 2012. They have purchased more than 50 Klover MiK™ systems in that time.
- The U.S. Patent Office has approved the patent covering the construction of the larger Klover MiK™ models.
- A second patent application was approved covering the construction of the Klover MiK-09.
- Klover Products has also developed a system, called the Klear Shot™, for removing water (rain) and debris from the lens of television cameras.
